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Preface

There are seasons when the Church must do more than gather, she must be stirred. August comes to us this year as such a season: a Month of Stirring and Warfare, in which the Lord is calling His people to awaken, to pray with new fervour, and to lay hold of the supernatural grace available to every believer who will contend for it.

This devotional was written to walk with you, day by day, through thirty-one focused encounters, each one built around a scripture, a central truth, a reflection, and three prayer points you can carry into your own place of prayer. Some days will stir you to warfare against forces that have hindered your family for years. Other days will lead you into worship, thanksgiving, and rest in God's faithfulness. Every day is designed to move you forward.

I encourage you to read slowly. Do not rush past the Scripture. Let the central truth settle into your spirit before you move to the reflection. And when you

come to the prayer points, do not merely read them, pray them, aloud if you are able, until you sense the shift that comes when heaven responds to importunate faith.

It is my prayer that by the time you reach Day 31, you will not be the same believer who began on Day 1. May this be, indeed, our month of stirring and warfare, and may it end in testimony.

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DAY 1

Pray for a Supernatural Stirring of Grace

“For an angel went down at a certain season into the pool, and troubled the water: whosoever then first after the troubling of the water stepped in was made whole of whatsoever disease he had.”
— JOHN 5:4 (KJV)

One Central Truth

Grace does not always meet you sitting still, grace stirs. Before Bethesda's miracle came, the water had to be troubled. God is announcing a stirring over August: a disturbing of every dry, settled place in your life until the supernatural rises to the surface. Do not fear the shaking. The stirring is not against you; it is for you. Step in the moment you sense it, and what has held you for years will let you go.

Reflection

There is a difference between a stagnant pool and a stirred one. Stagnant water breeds sickness; stirred

water carries healing. For thirty-eight years, a man lay by that pool watching others get their miracle while he stayed exactly where he was , not because God had forgotten him, but because he had no one to help him into the moving water. Beloved, this month, the Lord Himself is doing the stirring.

He is not waiting for you to organise your own breakthrough; He is troubling the waters of your finances, your body, your family, your assignment. What has felt frozen , a door that has not opened, a womb that has not opened, a business that has not opened , is about to be disturbed by grace.

The Holy Spirit does not stir without intention. Every movement of God is followed by an invitation to step in. Jesus eventually did for that man what the pool could not: He spoke, and strength returned to legs that had forgotten how to stand.

That same voice is speaking over you today. Do not analyse the stirring , respond to it. Get up. Take up whatever has been carrying you, and walk into the

new thing God is doing. This is your month to stop waiting by the pool and start walking in newness.

Prayer

- Father, stir the waters of my life and let Your grace disturb every dry and settled place.
- Lord Jesus, speak to every area that has stayed the same for too long and command it to rise.
- Holy Spirit, give me the sensitivity to recognise Your stirring and the courage to step in immediately.

DAY 2

Pray that Heaven Shall Open over the Church

“Bring ye all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be meat in mine house, and prove me now herewith, saith the LORD of hosts, if I will not open you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive.” — MALACHI 3:10 (KJV)

One Central Truth

There is a heaven above every faithful church, and it is not sealed shut, it is windowed, waiting to be opened. God ties open heavens to obedience, honour, and hunger. This month, HighCity is positioning herself under an open heaven: a place where prophecy flows, healing falls, provision descends, and destiny is accelerated. What is shut in the natural cannot remain shut once heaven begins to open over a praying, honouring, believing house.

Reflection

When Jesus was baptised, the text records something remarkable: the heavens were opened unto Him, and He saw the Spirit descending like a dove. Opened heavens are not reserved for the Old Testament alone; they are the inheritance of every generation that positions itself rightly before God.

Malachi shows us one key that opens heaven, bringing our all before God without holding back, and daring Him to prove Himself faithful. But there is a deeper key still: hunger. A church that is desperate for God, that refuses to settle for form without power, draws heaven's attention. This month, let HighCity Church become a house of open heavens, where members come expecting, where prayer is not a formality but a fire, where the Word is not merely taught but demonstrated.

When heaven opens over a church, everything changes: the sick begin to recover, the bound begin to break free, the confused begin to receive clarity, and the lost begin to find their way home. I am asking you

to pray specifically for this, not vague blessing, but an open heaven over every service, every prayer meeting, every altar call this August. Heaven is not stingy; heaven has simply been waiting for a people who will honour God enough to open the windows.

Prayer

- Father, open the windows of heaven over HighCity Church this month.
- Lord, let every service carry the manifest presence and power of an open heaven.
- In the name of Jesus, remove anything in me that would close heaven over the house of God.

DAY 3

Let Us Pray that the Church Shall Prevail over the Gates of Hell

“And I say also unto thee, That thou art Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it.” — MATTHEW 16:18 (KJV)

One Central Truth

The Church was never designed to hide from hell's gates, she was built to march against them and prevail. Gates are defensive structures; when Jesus said the gates of hell shall not prevail, He was revealing that the Church is on the offensive, not hell.

Every strategy assigned to weaken HighCity, division, discouragement, financial strangulation, moral compromise, is under assignment to be broken this month, because the Builder of this house has already declared the outcome.

Reflection

Notice the picture Jesus paints: gates do not attack, they defend. If the gates of hell cannot prevail against the Church, it means the Church is the one advancing, and hell is the one on the defensive. This changes how we should pray.

We are not begging God to protect a helpless church; we are decreeing, in agreement with Christ's own promise, that whatever hell has fortified against HighCity, every plot against her leadership, every attempt to scatter her members, every strategy to silence her voice in the city, shall not stand.

Caesarea Philippi, where Jesus spoke these words, was a region soaked in pagan worship, associated in that day with the very entrance to the underworld.

Jesus chose that exact location to declare His Church's victory. He is not intimidated by the strongholds around us; He builds His house in full view of the enemy's gates and still promises triumph.

This month, refuse to shrink back from whatever seems to be rising against the church, financial

pressure, spiritual attacks, external opposition. Instead, rise in confident prayer, reminding heaven and hell alike of what Christ has already spoken. The gates are shaking, not the Church.

Prayer

- Lord Jesus, let every gate of hell raised against HighCity Church be broken this month.
- Father, frustrate every counsel and strategy assigned to weaken or scatter this house.
- In the name of Jesus, I decree that the Church shall advance while every satanic gate falls.

DAY 4

Pray and Demolish Every Witchcraft Spirit Plaguing Families

“O foolish Galatians, who hath bewitched you, that ye should not obey the truth, before whose eyes Jesus Christ hath been evidently set forth, crucified among you?” — GALATIANS 3:1 (KJV)

One Central Truth

Witchcraft operates by hindering, it stalls marriages, confuses direction, provokes needless quarrels, and drains destinies of momentum. But every witchcraft assignment is powerless before the finished work of the cross.

The blood of Jesus, evidently set forth before the eyes of your family, is louder than every incantation spoken against you. This month, declare with confidence: what has bewitched my household is broken, in Jesus' name.

Reflection

Paul was astonished that a people who had clearly seen Christ crucified could still be hindered as though bewitched. Witchcraft's power is not in its noise but in its subtlety, it does not always announce itself; it simply hinders. A family that once moved in unity begins to quarrel over nothing.

A marriage that once thrived begins to grow cold without explanation. A child who was once brilliant begins to struggle inexplicably. These patterns, when they persist beyond natural explanation, call for spiritual discernment and aggressive prayer.

The good news is that no witchcraft can stand where the finished work of Calvary is truly believed and proclaimed. Jesus did not only die for our sins; He triumphed openly over principalities and powers, making a show of them at the cross.

This month, I want you to take authority over every hidden altar, every ancestral covenant, every generational pattern of confusion or delay operating in your bloodline. Name it before God, the quarrels, the sudden sicknesses, the repeated failures at the

point of breakthrough, and command it to loose its hold. You are not fighting flesh and blood; you are enforcing a victory that Christ has already won. Walk this month in bold, prayerful confidence, not fear.

Prayer

- Father, by the blood of Jesus, I break every witchcraft spirit operating against my family.
- Lord, expose and destroy every hidden altar assigned to hinder my household.
- In the name of Jesus, I command every confusion, quarrel, and delay sent by witchcraft to cease now.

DAY 5

Cast Out Every Demonic Spirit Operating in Your Life

“And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues.”, MARK 16:17 (KJV)

One Central Truth

Casting out is not merely a New Testament story, it is a present-tense authority given to every believer who dares to use the name of Jesus. Whatever spirit has attached itself to your emotions, your habits, your relationships, or your mind has no legal right to remain once you rise and command it to go. This is not a suggestion; it is a sign that follows those who believe.

Reflection

Many believers pray about a demonic spirit as though asking God to please, someday, remove it, but Jesus never framed deliverance as a request. He framed it as an exercise of delegated authority: in my name shall

they cast out devils. That authority was not given only to the twelve disciples; Mark records it as a sign that would follow all who believe, across every generation.

This month, take inventory honestly before God. Is there a spirit of anger that keeps erupting despite your best efforts? A spirit of lust that keeps returning after every resolution? A spirit of fear that paralyses you at the edge of every opportunity?

These are not simply personality traits to manage, some are spiritual oppressions to be cast out. The name of Jesus is not a formula; it is the authority of the risen Christ operating through your mouth when you speak in faith.

Do not negotiate with what God has already given you power over. Speak directly: in the name of Jesus, I command this spirit to leave. Follow it with worship, with the Word, and with a decision to walk in the opposite spirit. Deliverance is not the end of the fight; it is the beginning of a Spirit-filled walk.

Prayer

- In the name of Jesus, I cast out every demonic spirit operating in my life this day.
- Lord, fill every place that is emptied of darkness with the fullness of Your Holy Spirit.
- Father, give me grace to walk daily in the freedom Christ has purchased for me.

DAY 6

Command Every Evil Altar in Your Life to Break, as at Bethel

“And God said unto Jacob, Arise, go up to Bethel, and dwell there: and make there an altar unto God... Then Jacob said unto his household, and to all that were with him, Put away the strange gods that are among you.” — GENESIS 35:1-3 (KJV)

One Central Truth

Before God could bless Jacob's household afresh, every strange god buried under the family's tent had to be dug up and destroyed. Every altar, once erected, whether by your own hand or an ancestor's, remains active until it is deliberately broken. This month, God is calling you back to your Bethel: the place of true altars, where every strange covenant is renounced and true worship is restored.

Reflection

Jacob's household had accumulated foreign gods along the journey, idols picked up in Padan-aram,

charms carried perhaps out of superstition or convenience. God did not simply bless Jacob despite these idols; He commanded a cleansing first. Put away the strange gods. Purify yourselves. Then go up to Bethel.

There is a pattern here for every believer seeking a fresh encounter with God: revival often requires renunciation before it produces results. What strange altars has your family unknowingly carried, agreements made in desperation, charms inherited from grandparents, covenants entered before salvation, even subtle idols of money, status, or fear that now sit where God alone should reign?

This month, take time to examine your household honestly. Do not merely pray against altars in general terms; be specific before God about what needs to be renounced. Jacob's household buried their idols under an oak tree and never looked back, and it was there, at Bethel, that God renewed His covenant and blessed him as Israel. Your Bethel moment is available. Break every evil altar deliberately, replace it with true

worship, and watch God restore what those altars had stolen.

Prayer

- Father, expose every evil altar operating in my life and family, known or unknown.
- Lord, I renounce and break every strange covenant made on my behalf or by my own hand.
- In the name of Jesus, let true worship replace every false altar in my household.

DAY 7

Pray that the Covenant of Abundant Life Will Overwrite Every Curse of Scarcity

“The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.” – JOHN 10:10 (KJV)

One Central Truth

Scarcity is a thief's assignment, but abundance is Christ's covenant. Whatever has been quietly stealing from your finances, your health, or your joy is operating outside the will of the One who came to give life abundantly. This month, declare that the covenant of abundance in Christ overrides every inherited or spoken curse of lack, and watch scarcity lose its grip on your household.

Reflection

Jesus drew a sharp contrast in this verse between two visitors to your life: the thief, whose sole agenda is to

steal, kill, and destroy, and Himself, whose agenda is abundant life. Scarcity, that persistent sense that there is never enough, that money disappears mysteriously, that opportunities slip away just before they mature, often carries the fingerprints of the thief rather than the hand of God. Many believers accept lack as their portion without realising it may be a curse operating rather than simply 'hard times.'

A curse of scarcity can trace back to broken covenants, generational patterns of poverty accepted as normal, or even careless words spoken over a family's future. But here is good news: Christ did not merely come to reduce scarcity, He came to overwrite it entirely with abundant life.

Abundant life is not only about money; it is wholeness in every direction, health, peace, relationships, and provision flowing without the thief's constant interference. This month, refuse to make peace with lack.

Speak boldly against every curse of scarcity operating in your bloodline, and receive by faith the covenant

Christ purchased for you. Sow generously as an act of faith, expect divine provision, and watch the pattern of your household begin to shift from scarcity to sufficiency and overflow.

Prayer

- Father, in the name of Jesus, I break every curse of scarcity operating in my life and family.
- Lord, let the covenant of abundant life overwrite every pattern of lack I have inherited.
- In the name of Jesus, I command the thief to return sevenfold everything he has stolen from me.

DAY 8

Pray and Release Divine Visibility over Your Business and Shop

“Ye are the light of the world. A city that is set on an hill cannot be hid... Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.” –

MATTHEW 5:14-15 (KJV)

One Central Truth

Some businesses are excellent yet invisible, hidden not by lack of quality, but by a spiritual veil obstructing the eyes of the customers who need them. Divine visibility is different from marketing; it is God causing the right eyes to notice, the right feet to walk in, and the right favour to be released over your shop, your service, and your name in the marketplace.

Reflection

Jesus said a city set on a hill cannot be hidden, visibility is a natural consequence of position and light. Yet many hardworking believers labour

faithfully in business while remaining strangely unnoticed, as though a covering of obscurity sits over their signboard. This is not always a marketing problem; sometimes it is a spiritual one, requiring prayer rather than only strategy.

Pray this month for divine visibility: that your business would come out of hiddenness the way the sun breaks through cloud cover. Ask God to remove every veil of obscurity, every spirit of unnoticed labour, and every assignment designed to keep good work hidden from the customers who need it.

Pray also for divine connections, the right partners, the right referrals, the right testimonies that travel further than any advertisement could. Remember that light is not meant to be hidden under a bushel; God does not intend for your gifting or your enterprise to labour in the dark forever.

As you pray, also position yourself in excellence and integrity, because visibility that is not matched by quality will not endure. But where genuine excellence meets divine visibility, doors begin to open that no

human strategy could have opened, and your business becomes, in its own sphere, a light set on a hill.

Prayer

- Father, release divine visibility over my business, my shop, and my labour this month.
- Lord, connect me to the customers, partners, and opportunities assigned to my breakthrough.
- In the name of Jesus, I break every spirit of obscurity hiding my good work from the eyes that need it.

DAY 9

Pray that God Will Bless You, Enlarge Your Territory, and Keep You Safe Like Jabez

“And Jabez called on the God of Israel, saying, Oh that thou wouldest bless me indeed, and enlarge my coast, and that thine hand might be with me, and that thou wouldest keep me from evil, that it may not grieve me! And God granted him that which he requested.” – 1 CHRONICLES 4:10 (KJV)

One Central Truth

Jabez was born into pain, his very name meant sorrow, yet he refused to let his beginning define his end. His prayer was bold, specific, and complete: bless me, enlarge me, be with me, protect me. And Scripture records the simple, powerful result: God granted him that which he requested. Whatever sorrow marked your beginning, your prayer this month can rewrite your story.

Reflection

There is something instructive about how brief and direct Jabez's prayer was, yet how completely it covered every dimension of a flourishing life: blessing, enlargement, divine presence, and protection from evil. He did not simply ask to survive his painful name; he asked to be blessed indeed, an emphatic, undeniable blessing. He asked for enlarged territory, refusing to remain confined to small expectations. He asked for God's hand to be with him, understanding that presence matters more than provision alone. And he asked to be kept from evil, aware that increase without protection can become a burden rather than a joy.

This month, pray as boldly as Jabez prayed. Do not let a painful past, a discouraging name others have called you, or a history of setback shrink your prayers. Ask God plainly to bless you indeed, in health, finances, family, and influence. Ask Him to enlarge your territory, your business, your ministry, your sphere of impact. Ask for His hand to remain upon you daily, and ask Him to keep you from evil so that increase does not come with sorrow attached. The same God

who granted Jabez's request is not partial; He is waiting for you to ask boldly and specifically, and He will grant it.

Prayer

- Father, bless me indeed, and enlarge my coast in every direction this month.
- Lord, let Your hand be upon me daily, guiding and strengthening my steps.
- In the name of Jesus, keep me from evil, that my increase may not be accompanied by sorrow.

DAY 10

Pray that God Will Stir a Fresh Revival among His People

“O LORD, I have heard thy speech, and was afraid: O LORD, revive thy work in the midst of the years, in the midst of the years make known; in the midst of wrath remember mercy.”—

HABAKKUK 3:2 (KJV)

One Central Truth

Revival is not an event we schedule; it is a work we implore heaven to renew. Habakkuk's cry was simple yet urgent, revive Your work, a recognition that even genuine ministries can grow familiar and cold over time. This month, cry out with the same urgency: Lord, revive Your work among us, restore first love, and make Your power known afresh in the midst of these years.

Reflection

Habakkuk had heard of God's mighty works of old and trembled, yet his prayer was not nostalgia for the

past but hunger for the present: revive thy work in the midst of the years. He was not asking God to repeat history; he was asking God to bring the same fire into his own generation. This is a timeless prayer for every church and every believer. It is possible to attend services faithfully, sing familiar songs, and even serve diligently, while the fire that once burned within quietly dims to embers.

Revival begins the moment a people become honest enough to admit this and desperate enough to ask God to restore it. This month, pray fervently for a fresh revival among God's people, not merely emotional excitement, but a genuine visitation that restores holiness, ignites soul-winning zeal, deepens prayer, and awakens hunger for the Word.

Ask God to revive marriages that have grown routine, ministries that have grown mechanical, and personal devotion that has grown distracted. Revival always begins with individuals before it becomes corporate; let it begin with you. Do not wait for a scheduled crusade to encounter fresh fire, cry out today, in the

midst of your own years, and watch heaven answer with a visitation that changes everything.

Prayer

- Lord, revive Your work in the midst of these years, beginning with me.
- Father, restore the fire, the hunger, and the first love I once carried for You.
- In the name of Jesus, let a fresh wave of revival sweep through Your people this month.

DAY 11

Pray for Fresh Fire as upon Mount Carmel

“Then the fire of the LORD fell, and consumed the burnt sacrifice, and the wood, and the stones, and the dust, and licked up the water that was in the trench.” – 1 KINGS 18:38 (KJV)

One Central Truth

Elijah did not manufacture fire; he simply prepared the altar and prayed, and heaven answered with a fire so consuming that even the water in the trench disappeared. Mount Carmel remains a picture for every generation: when God's fire falls, it does not merely touch the surface, it consumes every rival claim to your devotion. This month, prepare your altar and expect fresh fire.

Reflection

The contest on Mount Carmel was never really about Elijah's power against Baal's prophets; it was about whose God could answer by fire. Elijah, confident in

the living God, drenched the altar with water three times over, removing every possible natural explanation, before he prayed a short, simple prayer of faith. The fire that fell was not ordinary; it consumed the sacrifice, the wood, the stones, the dust, and even licked up the water in the trench, leaving no doubt about whose God had answered.

This is the fire we need afresh this month, not a fire that merely warms us emotionally in a service, but a consuming fire that settles, once and for all, every question about whether God is truly at work among us. Pray for fire that consumes complacency, fire that consumes fear, fire that consumes compromise, fire that consumes every rival altar competing for your worship, career, comfort, popularity, even ministry itself when it becomes more about performance than devotion.

Like Elijah, prepare your altar honestly before God; do not hide behind excuses or half-hearted commitment. Then pray in simple faith, and watch

the fire of the Lord fall in a way that leaves no doubt to those watching that the Lord, He is God.

Prayer

- Lord, let Your fire fall upon the altar of my life as it fell on Mount Carmel.
- Father, consume every rival claim competing for my worship and devotion.
- In the name of Jesus, let fresh fire settle every doubt about Your presence and power among us.

DAY 12

Pray that God Will Send Labourers into the Vineyard

“Then saith he unto his disciples, The harvest truly is plenteous, but the labourers are few; Pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that he will send forth labourers into his harvest.” –

MATTHEW 9:37-38 (KJV)

One Central Truth

Jesus looked at a ready harvest and did not first command His disciples to go, He commanded them to pray. The shortage in soul-winning is rarely a shortage of harvest; it is a shortage of labourers willing to work it. This month, pray specifically that God would raise, equip, and thrust forth labourers, perhaps beginning with you, into the fields that are already white unto harvest.

Reflection

Before the sending of the twelve in the following chapter, Jesus first taught His disciples to pray for

labourers. This order matters. It reveals that God's harvest strategy always begins in the place of prayer before it moves into the field of labour. Jesus looked upon multitudes scattered like sheep without a shepherd and was moved with compassion, not frustration at their condition, but compassion that stirred Him to mobilise workers. This month, look around your own city, your workplace, your family, and your neighbourhood with the same eyes of compassion. The harvest is not lacking; people are hungry for meaning, searching for hope, weary from carrying burdens alone. What is lacking is labourers, those willing to give their time, comfort, and resources to bring in this harvest. Pray specifically that God would raise faithful, Spirit-filled labourers for HighCity Church's evangelism, missions, and discipleship efforts. Pray that God would thrust out labourers into unreached communities, into schools, into workplaces, into the marketplace. And do not merely pray for others to go, ask God whether He is calling you, even now, to become one of the labourers you are praying for. The Lord of the harvest is

listening for this prayer, and He delights to answer it by raising sent ones from among those who ask.

Prayer

- Lord of the harvest, send forth labourers into every field that is ripe unto harvest.
- Father, raise up faithful, Spirit-filled workers for HighCity Church's evangelism and missions.
- In the name of Jesus, show me my own part in this harvest and give me grace to labour faithfully.

DAY 13

Pray for a Fresh Anointing

“But my horn shalt thou exalt like the horn of an unicorn: I shall be anointed with fresh oil.” – PSALM 92:10 (KJV)

One Central Truth

Old oil, however powerful it once was, eventually needs replenishing. David did not ask merely to remember a past anointing, he declared confidently that he would be anointed with fresh oil, a continual renewing of divine enablement. Whatever anointing has carried you this far, this month is an invitation to receive fresh oil, poured afresh for the assignments ahead.

Reflection

The anointing that opened yesterday's doors is not automatically sufficient for tomorrow's battles. This is why David's declaration is so important, he did not rest on past experiences of God's power; he expected continual, fresh anointing as part of a flourishing life.

Just as physical oil is used up and must be replenished, spiritual anointing can grow stale when we lean only on old encounters rather than pursuing fresh ones.

This month, do not settle for yesterday's grace to carry today's challenges. Pray earnestly for fresh anointing, fresh grace to preach, fresh grace to lead your home, fresh grace to excel at your work, fresh grace to endure what once seemed unbearable. Fresh oil often comes through fresh consecration: renewed prayer, renewed fasting, renewed hunger for the Word, and renewed sensitivity to the Holy Spirit's voice. Examine your spiritual life honestly, has service become routine? Has worship become mechanical? These are signs that the oil may be running low.

Return to the place of intimate fellowship with God, and ask specifically for fresh oil to be poured over your head, your hands, your voice, and your vision. As with David, when fresh oil comes, strength returns, confidence returns, and your horn, a symbol of strength and authority, is exalted once again.

Prayer

- Father, anoint me afresh with the oil of Your Spirit for the assignments ahead.
- Lord, renew my hunger, my prayer life, and my sensitivity to Your voice.
- In the name of Jesus, let fresh grace flow through every area where the old oil has run dry.

DAY 14

Pray that God Will Activate the Ministry of Angels in Your Life

“Are they not all ministering spirits, sent forth to minister for them who shall be inherit salvation?” – HEBREWS 1:14 (KJV)

One Central Truth

Angels are not mythical figures reserved for Sunday school stories; Scripture describes them as ministering spirits actively sent forth on behalf of every believer. This month, pray with awareness that heaven has assigned angelic assistance to your life, for protection on dangerous roads, provision in difficult seasons, and direction at critical crossroads. Activate this ministry through faith-filled prayer.

Reflection

It is easy to read about angels in the accounts of Daniel, Elijah, or the shepherds at Bethlehem and imagine that such angelic activity belonged to a different, more dramatic era. But Hebrews makes

clear that angelic ministry continues even now, sent forth specifically to minister to those who shall be heirs of salvation, that includes you. Angels are dispatched for various assignments: Psalm 91 speaks of them keeping us in all our ways, bearing us up so that we do not dash our foot against a stone; Acts records an angel opening prison doors for Peter; another strengthened Jesus in Gethsemane.

This month, pray boldly for the ministry of angels to be activated around your life. Pray for angelic protection over your travels, your home, and your children. Pray for angelic assistance in circumstances that seem impossible in the natural, doors that need to be supernaturally opened, dangers that need to be supernaturally averted.

This is not superstition; it is simply believing what the Word already declares. As you pray, also walk in obedience and holiness, for angels respond to the Word of God spoken in faith. Fill your mouth with Scripture, decree God's promises over your life, and trust that the ministering spirits assigned to you are

already at work on your behalf, often unseen but never absent.

Prayer

- Father, activate the ministry of angels assigned to protect and assist me this month.
- Lord, send angelic assistance into every impossible situation I am facing.
- In the name of Jesus, let angels go before me, beside me, and behind me in every step I take.

DAY 15

Pray for the Release of Every Good Thing and the Fullness of Joy

“For the LORD God is a sun and shield: the LORD will give grace and glory: no good thing will he withhold from them that walk uprightly.” – PSALM 84:11 (KJV)

One Central Truth

God is not stingy with His children. He is described here as both sun and shield, warmth and protection in one, and the promise attached is breathtaking: no good thing will he withhold from them that walk uprightly. Whatever good thing has seemed withheld from you may not be God's refusal but a delay awaiting your continued uprightness and faith. This month, expect release.

Reflection

There is a quiet lie that often creeps into the hearts of sincere believers, the suspicion that God is somehow withholding good things from them, perhaps as

punishment, perhaps as a test with no clear end.

Psalm 84:11 dismantles this lie completely. It reveals God's character plainly: He is a sun, giving warmth, light, and life; He is a shield, giving protection from harm.

And the conclusion that flows from this character is definitive, no good thing will He withhold from those who walk uprightly. This does not mean life will be free of process or waiting, but it does mean that every good thing currently delayed is on its way, held not by God's reluctance but often by timing, preparation, or the maturing of your faith and character.

This month, pray specifically for the release of good things you have been believing God for, healing long prayed for, marriage long desired, breakthrough long awaited, reconciliation long hoped for, joy that has felt distant.

Ask the Holy Spirit to search your heart for anything hindering your walk of uprightness, and deal with it honestly. Then stand on this promise with confidence: because God is faithful to His Word, and

because you are walking uprightly before Him, every good thing being withheld by delay, not denial, is being released even now.

Prayer

- Father, release every good thing You have been holding for me until this appointed time.
- Lord, fill me with the fullness of joy that comes from Your presence.
- In the name of Jesus, remove anything in me that hinders the flow of Your blessing.

DAY 16

Pray for Healing from the Wings of the Lord Jesus Christ

“But unto you that fear my name shall the Sun of righteousness arise with healing in his wings; and ye shall go forth ye that go forth as calves of the house of the stall.” – MALACHI 4:2 (KJV)

One Central Truth

Healing is not merely something Jesus does, it is described as flowing directly from His very wings, His nature, His presence. Wherever the Sun of righteousness arises, healing accompanies Him automatically, like rays inseparable from sunlight. This month, position yourself under the arising of this Sun, and expect healing to touch your body, your emotions, and your relationships.

Reflection

The imagery in Malachi is striking, healing is carried in the wings of the Sun of righteousness, arising the way the natural sun rises each morning bringing light

and warmth without fail. This tells us something vital: healing is not an occasional favour Jesus dispenses reluctantly; it is inherent to His nature, arising wherever He is welcomed. The verse also promises that those who receive this healing shall go forth as calves of the stall, a picture of vigorous, unrestrained leaping, energy long confined suddenly released into joyful movement.

This month, bring every area needing healing before the Lord, physical sicknesses that have lingered, emotional wounds carried silently for years, broken relationships that need restoration, memories that still cause pain when touched. Do not merely ask for healing as a distant hope; position yourself under the arising of the Sun of righteousness through worship, through the Word, and through unwavering faith in His finished work.

Remember, by His stripes we were healed, this is not a future promise alone but a present reality to be appropriated by faith. As you fear His name, that is, reverence and trust Him completely, expect healing to arise in your life the way sunlight arises each morning:

consistently, powerfully, and without fail. Then, like calves released from the stall, go forth rejoicing in restored strength.

Prayer

- Lord Jesus, let healing arise in my body, my emotions, and my relationships this month.
- Father, I receive by faith the healing that flows from Your finished work at the cross.
- In the name of Jesus, release me to go forth rejoicing, free from every sickness and pain.

DAY 17

Pray for Grace to Do Exploits

“...but the people that do know their God shall be strong, and do exploits.” – DANIEL 11:32 (KJV)

One Central Truth

Exploits are not achieved by the merely religious but by those who know their God intimately. Knowledge here is relational, not academic, an experiential grasp of God's faithfulness that produces strength and boldness others cannot muster. This month, pray not just for blessing, but for grace to do exploits: extraordinary feats of faith that mark this season as unforgettable.

Reflection

There is a category of believer described in this verse whose defining feature is not talent, wealth, or education, but knowledge of their God, an intimate, tested, proven relationship built through seasons of prayer, obedience, and dependence. Out of this knowledge flows two remarkable results: strength and

exploits. Strength to endure what would break others, and exploits, bold, faith-filled actions that accomplish what seemed impossible.

This month, do not settle for merely surviving; pray for grace to do exploits in every sphere God has placed you, business, ministry, family, and personal growth. Exploits might mean stepping into an assignment that terrifies you but that God has clearly called you to. It might mean confronting a stronghold in your family that generations before you were too afraid to challenge. It might mean starting a venture, writing a book, planting a ministry, or reconciling a relationship everyone said was beyond repair.

The common thread among those who do exploits throughout Scripture, David facing Goliath, Esther approaching the king, Gideon leading three hundred against thousands, is not the absence of fear, but a deep knowledge of God that overrides fear with faith. This month, deepen your knowledge of God through prayer and the Word, and watch that intimacy

translate into strength for exploits others will remember for years to come.

Prayer

- Father, deepen my knowledge of You until it produces unshakable strength within me.
- Lord, give me grace to do exploits that reveal Your power in my generation.
- In the name of Jesus, remove every fear that would keep me from the bold assignment You have given me.

DAY 18

Pray that God Will Deliver You from Evil

“And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil: For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever.

Amen.” – MATTHEW 6:13 (KJV)

One Central Truth

Jesus taught His disciples to pray for deliverance from evil as a normal, necessary part of daily prayer, not a rare emergency request but a continual dependence on God's protection. Evil takes many forms: temptation, accident, sickness, satanic attack, and the schemes of wicked people. This month, pray daily and specifically for deliverance, trusting that the kingdom, power, and glory belong to the One who protects you.

Reflection

The Lord's Prayer ends not with a request for blessing alone, but with a plea for deliverance, a reminder that even the most devoted follower of Christ needs

ongoing divine protection from the evil that surrounds daily life. Jesus did not consider this request unnecessary or the sign of weak faith; He built it into the pattern He gave His disciples for prayer.

This month, take seriously your need for God's continual deliverance. Pray specifically against temptation that would compromise your integrity, evil circumstances that could arise unexpectedly, accidents, sudden sicknesses, dangerous encounters, and the schemes of those who wish you harm, whether through gossip, manipulation, or outright opposition.

Deliverance is not evidence of weakness; it is wisdom, an acknowledgment that we live in a world where evil is real and active, and that our safety ultimately rests in God's hands, not our own vigilance alone. Notice how the prayer concludes, not in fear, but in confident worship: for thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, forever.

This is the posture to maintain even as you pray for deliverance: not anxious pleading, but confident

worship, resting in the certainty that the One who reigns over all kingdoms, all power, and all glory is fully able and fully willing to keep you from every form of evil this month and beyond.

Prayer

- Father, lead me not into temptation, but deliver me from every form of evil.
- Lord, protect me from accidents, sickness, and the schemes of wicked people.
- In the name of Jesus, I rest in Your kingdom, power, and glory as my sure protection.

DAY 19

Pray for Fresh Wisdom and Revelation

“That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give unto you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of him.” – EPHESIANS 1:17 (KJV)

One Central Truth

Paul did not pray that the Ephesians would simply gain more information, he prayed for the spirit of wisdom and revelation, a supernatural capacity to perceive what natural understanding cannot grasp. This month, pray this same prayer over your own life: that God would open the eyes of your understanding, granting wisdom for daily decisions and revelation for the deeper mysteries of His will concerning you.

Reflection

There is a vast difference between information and revelation. Information can be gathered through study and experience; revelation is a gift, a spiritual

unveiling given only by the Father of glory. Paul's prayer for the Ephesians was specific and deliberate, not for more knowledge about God from a distance, but for a spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him, an intimate, experiential understanding that transforms how one lives.

This month, many of us stand at crossroads requiring wisdom beyond our natural capacity, decisions about marriage, career, ministry, finances, and relationships that no amount of human counsel alone can fully settle.

Pray specifically for this spirit of wisdom to be released over your mind, granting clarity where confusion has reigned and discernment where deception has lurked. Pray also for revelation, a deeper unveiling of God's purposes for your life, your family, and your assignment on earth.

Many believers wander for years, uncertain of direction, simply because they have not earnestly sought this specific grace. As you pray this month, expect not only answers to immediate questions but

an ongoing deepening of your relationship with God, for revelation ultimately draws you closer to Him, not merely to information about your circumstances. Let this be your cry: Father of glory, open the eyes of my understanding, that I might know You more.

Prayer

- Father, give me the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the deep knowledge of You.
- Lord, open the eyes of my understanding to perceive Your will clearly.
- In the name of Jesus, grant me wisdom for every decision I must make this month.

DAY 20

Pray that Christ Will Be Formed in Us

“My little children, of whom I travail in birth again until Christ be formed in you.” – GALATIANS 4:19 (KJV)

One Central Truth

Paul's ultimate goal for the Galatians was not merely correct doctrine, but Christlike character, Christ formed in them, the way a child is formed in a mother's womb, gradually, deliberately, until fully shaped. This month, pray not only for outward breakthrough, but for the inward, often painful process of Christ being formed more fully in your character, your speech, and your responses.

Reflection

There is a temptation in seasons of prayer and warfare to focus entirely on external breakthrough, finances, healing, promotion, while neglecting the deeper work God desires to do within us. Paul's language here is

intensely personal: he travails, as in birth pains, until Christ is formed in the Galatians. Formation takes time; it cannot be rushed, and it often involves discomfort, much like the process of childbirth itself.

This month, invite God to do this deeper work in you even as you contend for outward victories. Ask Him to form patience in you where impatience has ruled, to form gentleness in you where harshness has reigned, to form forgiveness in you where bitterness has taken root, and to form humility in you where pride has quietly grown.

This is often the harder prayer to pray, because it requires honest self-examination rather than only external petition. Yet it is the truest mark of spiritual maturity: not simply receiving more from God, but becoming more like Him. As Christ is formed in you, your prayers themselves will carry greater authority, your witness will carry greater weight, and your life will increasingly reflect the very character of the One you serve.

Do not resist the shaping process this month, even when it is uncomfortable, welcome it, for it is Christ Himself being formed within you.

Prayer

- Father, form the character of Christ in me, even through the discomfort of the process.
- Lord, replace every trace of pride, bitterness, and impatience with Your own likeness.
- In the name of Jesus, let my life increasingly reflect the image of Christ to those around me.

DAY 21

Pray that the Lord Will Stir the Church to Walk in the Supernatural

“And when they had prayed, the place was shaken where they were assembled together; and they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and spake the word of God with boldness.” – ACTS 4:31 (KJV)

One Central Truth

The early church did not settle for ordinary gatherings, their united prayer produced a shaking, a fresh filling of the Holy Ghost, and bold proclamation of the Word. The supernatural was their normal. This month, pray that HighCity Church would return to this pattern: a people so given to united prayer that our meeting places are shaken, and boldness replaces timidity in our witness.

Reflection

It is worth noticing what happened immediately after this praying company asked God for boldness in the

face of persecution: the place was shaken, they were filled afresh with the Holy Ghost, and they spoke the Word with boldness. This was not an isolated event reserved for the apostolic age; it is a pattern available to any praying, united company of believers who dare to ask God for the same.

This month, pray earnestly that HighCity Church would walk more fully in the supernatural, not sensationalism, but genuine manifestations of God's power: healings that cannot be explained away, deliverances that break generational chains, prophetic words that bring clarity and direction, and boldness that causes believers to speak the gospel fearlessly regardless of opposition or ridicule.

The supernatural is not reserved for a select few; it is the inheritance of every Spirit-filled believer united in prayer. Examine whether fear, tradition, or unbelief has quietly reduced our gatherings to mere routine, and ask God to shake us out of complacency the way that upper room was literally shaken.

Pray for a return to united, fervent, expectant prayer as a church family, believing that the same God who answered that early gathering is ready to answer HighCity Church with fresh boldness and supernatural demonstration this very month.

Prayer

- Lord, shake HighCity Church out of complacency into fervent, united prayer.
- Father, fill us afresh with the Holy Ghost and give us boldness to speak Your Word.
- In the name of Jesus, let the supernatural become our normal as a praying church family.

DAY 22

Pray against Every Scheme Designed to Cause Backsliding

“Ye therefore, beloved, seeing ye know these things before, beware lest ye also, being led away with the error of the wicked, fall from your own steadfastness.” – 2 PETER 3:17 (KJV)

One Central Truth

Backsliding rarely happens overnight; it is usually the result of a scheme, a slow error subtly leading a believer away from steadfastness. Peter's warning is a call to vigilance, not fear. This month, pray specifically against every scheme, distraction, offense, compromise, weariness, designed to lead you or your loved ones away from the faith once sincerely embraced.

Reflection

Peter's warning is tender but urgent: beloved, beware. He does not describe backsliding as a single dramatic collapse but as being led away gradually, deceived by

error until steadfastness is lost. This should alert every believer to examine the small compromises that often precede a great fall, skipped prayer times that become habitual, offenses nursed quietly until bitterness sets in, entertainment choices that slowly dull spiritual sensitivity, relationships that gradually pull one away from godly influence.

This month, pray specifically and by name for anyone in your family or circle who seems to be drifting, recognising that the goal is not condemnation but restoration. Pray also for your own heart, asking the Holy Spirit to reveal any subtle drift you may not have noticed in yourself.

The enemy's schemes against steadfastness are rarely obvious; they are designed to appear reasonable, harmless, even justified. This is why Peter calls for beloved vigilance rather than casual confidence. Strengthen your own steadfastness this month through renewed commitment to prayer, the Word, and fellowship, and stand in the gap for others who may be wavering.

Backsliding can be reversed just as surely as it can begin, and this month is a fitting time to pray fervently for a great turning back to steadfast faith, both for yourself and for every wandering soul known to you.

Prayer

- Father, expose and destroy every scheme designed to lead me or my loved ones into backsliding.
- Lord, strengthen my steadfastness and restore anyone in my family who has begun to drift.
- In the name of Jesus, keep me alert to every subtle compromise before it grows into a great fall.

DAY 23

Pray that God Will Keep You in Perfect Peace

“Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee: because he trusteth in thee.” – ISAIAH 26:3 (KJV)

One Central Truth

Perfect peace is not the absence of trouble but the presence of a mind fixed steadily on God despite trouble. The condition is clear: a mind stayed on Him, a heart that trusts Him. This month, in the midst of spiritual warfare, financial pressure, or family challenges, guard your mind fiercely, fixing it on God's faithfulness, and receive the perfect peace He has promised to those who trust Him fully.

Reflection

Notice the precise mechanism Isaiah describes for receiving perfect peace, it is not achieved through the absence of difficulty, nor through willpower alone, but through a mind stayed on God and a heart that

trusts Him. A stayed mind is one that refuses to wander into anxious speculation, refuses to rehearse worst-case scenarios repeatedly, and instead deliberately fixes its attention on who God is and what He has promised.

This is an active discipline, not a passive feeling. This month, amid the intensity of spiritual warfare and prayer, it is easy for the mind to grow anxious, imagining the worst about health, finances, relationships, or ministry. Resist this pull deliberately.

Whenever anxious thoughts arise, consciously redirect your mind toward Scripture, toward worship, toward remembrance of God's past faithfulness in your life. Trust is the companion virtue to a stayed mind, believing not only that God can act, but that He is good and faithful even amid delay or difficulty.

As you practise this discipline daily, you will find that perfect peace is not a rare, fleeting emotion but a steady, sustaining reality available even in the fiercest storm. Let this month be marked not by anxiety but by a supernatural calm that causes others to ask how

you remain so steady, and let your answer always point them back to the God on whom your mind is stayed.

Prayer

- Father, keep my mind stayed on You, that I may walk in perfect peace this month.
- Lord, silence every anxious thought and replace it with steady trust in Your faithfulness.
- In the name of Jesus, let Your peace guard my heart and mind through every trial.

DAY 24

Pray that the Nations Shall Flow into HighCity Church

“And it shall come to pass in the last days, that the mountain of the LORD’s house shall be established in the top of the mountains... and all nations shall flow unto it.” – ISAIAH 2:2 (KJV)

One Central Truth

Isaiah’s prophecy pictures a house so established, so exalted in spiritual authority, that nations themselves are drawn to flow toward it. This is the vision for HighCity Church, not confinement to a single locality or people, but a house whose influence and testimony draw people from every nation and background. Pray boldly that this prophetic picture becomes present reality in our generation.

Reflection

The image Isaiah paints is striking: a mountain, established above every other mountain, toward

which nations naturally flow, not driven by force or compulsion, but drawn by the manifest presence and authority resting upon that house. This month, let us pray this exact prophecy over HighCity Church. Ask God to establish this house so firmly in spiritual authority, integrity, and demonstrated power that people from various nations, cultures, and backgrounds are naturally drawn to her, whether physically present in Accra or connected through the reach of media and testimony.

Pray for HighCity's influence to expand beyond Ghana, touching the diaspora, reaching neighbouring nations, and eventually influencing distant lands, just as Isaiah foresaw. This flowing is rarely automatic; it follows established houses, places where God's presence, sound teaching, and genuine transformation are evidently at work.

Pray therefore not only for expanded influence but for the depth of character and demonstrated power that would make such expansion sustainable and fruitful rather than shallow. Pray for wisdom for the leadership as the church grows, for grace to disciple

new believers from diverse backgrounds, and for unity that transcends cultural and national differences.

This month, believe God for divine connections that open unexpected doors of influence, and watch as HighCity Church steps increasingly into the fulfilment of this ancient, glorious prophecy.

Prayer

- Father, establish HighCity Church in such authority that nations flow unto her.
- Lord, expand our influence and reach beyond Ghana to the nations of the earth.
- In the name of Jesus, give us grace to disciple and unite people from every nation and background.

DAY 25

Pray that God Will Increase Us with Men as a Flock

“I will yet for this be enquired of by the house of Israel, to do it for them; I will increase them with men like a flock. As the holy flock... so shall the waste cities be filled with flocks of men.” –

EZEKIEL 36:37-38 (KJV)

One Central Truth

God's promise of increase here is tied explicitly to being enquired of, to prayer. He does not increase His people arbitrarily; He waits to be asked. This month, pray specifically that HighCity Church would be increased with men, women, and families like a flock, the wasted, empty spaces filled with new believers, new members, and restored ones returning home.

Reflection

There is something remarkable about how God frames this promise of increase, He ties it directly to intercession: I will yet for this be enquired of. In other words, the fulfilment of this beautiful promise of a

flourishing, filled congregation is connected to the persistent prayers of His people. This month, do not merely hope passively for church growth; enquire of God specifically and persistently for it.

Picture the imagery Ezekiel uses, waste cities, once desolate, filled again with flocks of men, much like the crowded, joyful gathering at a great feast in Jerusalem. This is the picture for HighCity Church: empty seats filled, small cell groups multiplying, families who once attended alone now bringing relatives and friends, backslidden members returning home, and entirely new souls added through evangelism and testimony.

Pray specifically for numerical increase, but also for the depth of discipleship needed to sustain such growth meaningfully, for growth without depth quickly becomes fragile. Ask God to soften hardened hearts in your own family and social circles, to open doors for genuine gospel conversations, and to give the church wisdom in receiving and nurturing every new soul added.

As with Ezekiel's prophecy, the waste places are not permanently waste, they are simply waiting to be enquired of through fervent, believing prayer, until they overflow with life once again.

Prayer

- Father, increase HighCity Church with men, women, and families like a flock.
- Lord, fill every empty seat and every waste place in our congregation with new life.
- In the name of Jesus, give me boldness to bring souls into this house through my witness.

DAY 26

Pray that God Will Set a Hedge of Protection around Your Business and Finances

“Hast not thou made an hedge about him, and about his house, and about all that he hath on every side? thou hast blessed the work of his hands, and his substance is increased in the land.” –

JOB 1:10 (KJV)

One Central Truth

Satan himself admitted that a hedge surrounded Job's life, his household, and everything he possessed, a spiritual barrier the enemy could not cross without divine permission. This month, pray for that same kind of hedge to surround your business, your finances, and your possessions: a protective boundary that keeps thieves, losses, and satanic attack far from what God has blessed.

Reflection

It is significant that this description of a hedge comes not from Job himself, but from the mouth of the accuser. Even Satan recognised that he could not touch Job's household, possessions, or work without first being granted limited permission by God. This tells us something important, divine hedges are real, and they are formidable even to spiritual forces of great cunning and malice.

This month, pray specifically for such a hedge to surround your business, your finances, your investments, and your possessions. Ask God to build a boundary that prevents unnecessary losses, sudden theft, fraudulent schemes, and satanic sabotage of your hard-earned resources.

This is not a prayer of presumption but of faith, grounded in the same principle that protected Job's substantial wealth for years before any testing began. As you pray for this hedge, also walk in wisdom, practising diligence, integrity, and sound stewardship, for a hedge protects what is being cared for responsibly, not carelessly.

Pray also for discernment to recognise early warning signs of fraudulent schemes or bad partnerships before they cause damage. Trust that the same God who permitted a hedge around Job's household is willing and able to build one around your own labour and increase, keeping it secure until it multiplies into the fullness of what He intends for you.

Prayer

- Father, set a hedge of protection around my business, my finances, and my possessions.
- Lord, block every scheme of theft, fraud, and satanic sabotage assigned against my increase.
- In the name of Jesus, prosper the work of my hands and keep it secure until it multiplies.

DAY 27

Pray that God Will Endue Us with Power from on High

“And, behold, I send the promise of my Father upon you: but tarry ye in the city of Jerusalem, until ye be endued with power from on high.” – LUKE 24:49 (KJV)

One Central Truth

Jesus instructed His disciples not to rush into ministry, however urgent the mission felt, until they were first endued with power from on high. Natural zeal and good intentions are insufficient substitutes for supernatural enduement. This month, pray earnestly for this same power, not human effort dressed in spiritual language, but genuine enduement that equips you for the assignment ahead.

Reflection

It would have been reasonable for the disciples, freshly commissioned by the risen Christ, to immediately rush out preaching. Instead, Jesus commanded them to tarry, to wait deliberately, until they were endued

with power from on high. This teaches an important principle: effective ministry and Christian living flow not from human enthusiasm alone, but from supernatural enduement received through waiting upon God.

This month, examine whether you have been operating largely in your own strength, pushing through challenges, striving in ministry, managing your household through sheer willpower, while neglecting this vital enduement of power. Pray earnestly, as the disciples eventually did in the upper room, for the Holy Spirit to clothe you afresh with power for whatever assignment lies ahead: raising your children in godliness, excelling at your workplace, serving effectively in ministry, or overcoming a besetting weakness.

This enduement is not a one-time event to be remembered nostalgically; it is available continually to those who tarry, wait, and ask. Do not despise seasons of waiting upon God this month, even amid urgent demands and busy schedules. Set aside deliberate time

to seek this power, understanding that what flows from an empowered life will always accomplish more than what flows from mere natural effort, however sincere that effort may be.

Prayer

- Father, endue me with power from on high for every assignment You have given me.
- Lord, teach me to tarry in Your presence rather than striving in my own strength.
- In the name of Jesus, clothe me afresh with the power of the Holy Spirit this month.

DAY 28

Keep the Fire Burning

“The fire shall ever be burning upon the altar; it shall never go out.” – LEVITICUS 6:13 (KJV)

One Central Truth

God commanded Israel's priests to maintain a fire on the altar continuously, not occasionally rekindled, but ever burning, never permitted to go out. Spiritual fire is not sustained automatically; it requires deliberate, daily attention.

This month, having received fresh oil, fresh anointing, and fresh visitation, commit to the sacred discipline of keeping that fire burning long after the special season of prayer concludes.

Reflection

It is one thing to experience a season of fresh fire; it is another matter entirely to maintain it once the intensity of special prayer meetings and corporate

gatherings has passed. God's instruction to the priests was specific and unrelenting, the fire shall never go out. This required continual attention: adding fuel, tending the coals, guarding against neglect.

The same principle applies to our spiritual lives. It is not enough to experience powerful encounters during a season of stirring and warfare if we allow the fire to die down once daily routine resumes.

This month, as we approach the conclusion of these days of intense prayer, ask yourself honestly what daily disciplines will keep your fire burning: consistent personal devotion, faithful attendance at corporate worship, ongoing accountability with fellow believers, continued feeding on the Word beyond a single season.

Fire that is not tended eventually dies, regardless of how intensely it once burned. Commit today to specific, practical steps that will sustain what God has ignited in you this month, a set time of daily prayer, a discipline of Scripture reading, a renewed commitment to fellowship and service.

Let this not merely be a memorable season you look back on, but the beginning of a lifestyle of continual fire that never goes out, long after August has ended.

Prayer

- Father, help me maintain daily disciplines that keep the fire You have ignited burning continually.
- Lord, do not let complacency or busyness quench what You have started in me this month.
- In the name of Jesus, let the fire of Your presence remain ever burning in my life, never to go out.

DAY 29

Pray that God Will Revive the Church to Shine as the Light of the World

“Ye are the light of the world. A city that is set on an hill cannot be hid... Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.” – MATTHEW 5:14, 16 (KJV)

One Central Truth

Jesus did not command His followers to become light, He declared that they already are light, and simply instructed them to let that light shine visibly. This month, pray that HighCity Church, and every believer within her, would let their light shine so brightly through good works and holy living that many are drawn to glorify our Father in heaven.

Reflection

There is a subtle but important distinction in how Jesus addressed His disciples, He did not tell them to try to become light; He declared what they already

were: the light of the world. The command that follows is simply to let that light shine, removing whatever hinders its visibility rather than manufacturing light that was never theirs to create. This month, pray that HighCity Church would remove every hindrance to its light, compromise, inconsistency between profession and practice, internal division that dims our collective witness.

Pray also that individual believers would let their personal light shine clearly at home, at work, and in the marketplace, through visible good works rather than mere words. The world is not searching primarily for eloquent arguments about God; it is searching, often unknowingly, for evidence, lives so transformed, so marked by integrity, love, and supernatural power, that the only reasonable explanation is the reality of God at work.

Pray that HighCity Church would become such evidence in Accra and beyond, a city set on a hill, impossible to overlook, whose good works consistently point observers not to the church's own

greatness, but to the Father in heaven who deserves all the glory. Let this month mark a fresh commitment to letting our light shine unhindered before a watching world.

Prayer

- Father, remove every hindrance to the light of HighCity Church shining brightly.
- Lord, let my own life reflect such good works that others glorify You because of it.
- In the name of Jesus, make us a city set on a hill, impossible to overlook or ignore.

DAY 30

Pray for the Bishop and Leadership of HighCity Church

“Obey them that have the rule over you, and submit yourselves: for they watch for your souls, as they that must give account, that they may do it with joy, and not with grief.” – HEBREWS 13:17 (KJV)

One Central Truth

Leadership carries a weight of accountability that the congregation rarely sees, watching for souls, giving account before God, carrying burdens often in silence. This month, pray specifically and earnestly for the Bishop and every leader of HighCity Church: for wisdom in decision-making, protection from attack, fresh anointing for the assignment, and joy rather than grief as they faithfully watch over God’s flock.

Reflection

Behind every visible ministry moment, a powerful sermon, a well-run service, a thriving department, lies an unseen weight of responsibility carried by

leadership: watching over souls, praying through difficult decisions, absorbing criticism, and standing accountable before God for the direction of the house. Hebrews reminds the congregation that leaders carry out this task in one of two postures, with joy, or with grief, and that our own submission and support directly influence which posture our leaders experience.

This month, commit to praying specifically and by name for the Bishop and every leader within HighCity Church. Pray for wisdom that exceeds human understanding in every decision, both large and small. Pray for divine protection over their health, their families, their reputation, and their spiritual walk, recognising that leaders are frequent targets of the enemy's most concentrated attacks.

Pray for fresh anointing that renews their strength daily, preventing burnout and discouragement. Pray for faithful, trustworthy teams to surround and support them, sharing the load rather than leaving them isolated. And pray specifically that their labour over this house would be met with joy rather than

grief, joy that comes when a congregation walks in unity, obedience, and genuine spiritual growth. As you pray this month, also examine your own posture toward leadership, ensuring that your own life contributes to their joy rather than their burden.

Prayer

- Father, grant the Bishop and every leader of HighCity Church wisdom for every decision they must make.
- Lord, protect their health, families, and reputation from every attack of the enemy.
- In the name of Jesus, let their leadership over this house be met with joy and not grief.

DAY 31

Thank God for Answered Prayers

“Bless the LORD, O my soul: and all that is within me, bless his holy name. Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits.” – PSALM 103:1-2 (KJV)

One Central Truth

After thirty days of stirring, warfare, and believing prayer, the fitting conclusion is not another petition, but wholehearted thanksgiving. David's charge to his own soul, forget not all his benefits, reminds us that gratitude must be deliberate, or the memory of God's faithfulness quickly fades. This month closes not in striving, but in praise, as we thank God for every prayer He has already answered.

Reflection

It is significant that David does not merely thank God in general terms but specifically commands his own soul not to forget all His benefits, a deliberate act of remembrance, because gratitude does not sustain itself automatically; it must be intentionally

cultivated. As this month of stirring and warfare draws to its close, take time to look back honestly over the past thirty-one days.

Recall the stirrings you have sensed, the open doors that have appeared, the fresh fire that has fallen, the healing that has come, the wisdom that has been granted, and the countless answers, both large and small, that may otherwise be quickly forgotten amid the busyness of daily life. Gratitude is not merely good manners toward God; it is a spiritual discipline that positions us for continued blessing, for a thankful heart honours God and invites further grace, while an ungrateful heart, as Scripture warns, invites spiritual decline.

Take time today, perhaps even in written form, to record specifically what God has done for you this month. Gather with your household, your cell group, or the wider church family, if possible, to testify openly of answered prayers, for testimony strengthens the faith of others even as it deepens your own gratitude.

Let this closing day not be a quiet ending but a resounding, joyful declaration: bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all His benefits. Carry this spirit of thanksgiving and consecration into the new month ahead, expectant for even greater things to come.

Prayer

- Father, I bless Your holy name for every prayer You have answered this month.
- Lord, I thank You specifically for the stirring, the fire, and the breakthroughs You have released.
- In the name of Jesus, I consecrate myself afresh, expecting even greater things in the days ahead.

Closing Thanksgiving

You have walked through thirty-one days of stirring, of warfare, of worship, and of thanksgiving. Whatever you carried into August, a burden, a barrenness, a battle, carry it no longer as it was. The stirring has done its work. The altars have been broken. The fire has fallen.

Let this not be the end of your fervency but the beginning of a new normal: a life of continual prayer, unbroken fellowship with the Holy Spirit, and confident expectation of God's power at work in and through you.

Give God thanks today, and step into the new month consecrated, stirred, and ready for greater exploits.
